



# The Fairmount Greenway And Codman Square: An Overview

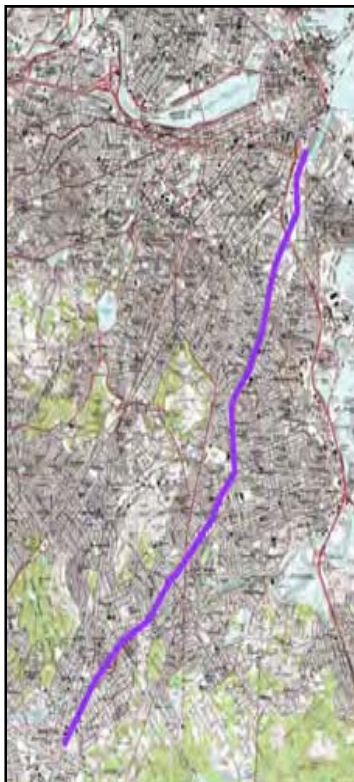
*The plan for the Fairmount Greenway is a path running alongside the Fairmount Commuter Rail Line that will link nearby existing and new open areas, creating a ribbon of green space that weaves back and forth through the adjacent neighborhoods. A multi-use pedestrian and bicycle path will span the length of the Fairmount Line from Downtown Boston to Hyde Park and provide connections between parks, community gardens, schools, historic sites, community centers and shopping districts.*

Codman Square NDC is a member of the Fairmount Greenway Task Force. The Greenway will not only provide direct access to the new Talbot Ave. MBTA station on the Fairmount Commuter Rail Line, it will also help to revitalize our neighborhood. This ambitious plan includes the creation of new public open spaces for our community and the development of new transportation options.



## The General Route:

The Fairmount Greenway will roughly parallel the Fairmount Line of the MBTA (pictured) which runs from Downtown Boston all the way to Hyde Park. Each neighborhood along the route will benefit, including, those who live, work, and play in the greater Codman Square area.



## The Route Locally:

The Fairmount Greenway will pass right through the heart of the Codman Square area. Both the Four Corners and Talbot Ave. MBTA stops of the revitalized Fairmount Commuter Rail Line will be part of the Greenway's path.
