H.3315/S.2271: An Act Improving Rail Service on the Fairmount Commuter Rail Line



MORE FREQUENT SERVICE

This bill would require more frequent service so that trains run in both directions every 7.5 minutes by 2029 and every 5 minutes in both directions by 2035.



ELECTRIFIED TRAINS

Require construction to begin for electrification of the line by November 30, 2023. Require full electrification of the line by December 31, 2024. No more pollution in our neighborhoods!



MORE ACCESSIBLE, CONVENIENT, & AFFORDABLE

Implement uniform fares at the same cost as the subway, including Readville Station; Require free transfers to bus and subway; Synchronize connecting bus and train schedules.


